Grade 11 Duke of Edinburgh Silver Trial Expedition, 30 April - 2 May 2014

Just a few days after the Bronze Trial Expedition (see our report in last week's Bulletin), three groups of Grade 11 students, currently practicing for their Silver DofE Final Expedition later in June, made their way to the Harz Mountains where they spent three days hiking and camping in the area between Clausthal-Zellerfeld and Osterode. In comparison with

the rolling hills of the Lüneburger Heide where Bronze the Tria1 took place a week earlier. and the wonderful weather the Grade students experienced there. this was definitely more

vigorous and

challenging expedition, not only considering the sometimes quite severe rise and fall in the landscape and a total of 3 hikes, but also as regards the weather conditions that varied between sunshine on Day 1, rain on Day 2 and fog and a bitterly cold start to Day 3. Carrying backpacks with all their essential items such as spare clothing, food, sleeping bag/roll, tent and cooking stoves/utensils and walking distances of up to 20km per day, all students completed their planned routes, despite encountering a variety of mishaps and difficulties on the way and, of course, oh! those aching limbs!

All now seem well prepared to participate in the Silver Final Expedition, a date for which is currently being co-ordinated.

Indoor Rowing Competition, 5 and 6 May 2014

On Monday and Tuesday of this week, students from Grades 5, 6, and 7 participated in a nationwide, indoor rowing event "The Fastest Class of Germany". In cooperation with the Bremer Ruderverein von 1882 e.V., we had two fantastic days of rowing at our school. Each student had to row 250m on the rowing machine, and the fastest eight times of each class were added together to a total and with this time they will compete against other schools in Germany. It was great to see their commitment and the amount of energy the students put into this activity, and considering they were using these machines for the first time, they all did very well.

Grade 8 students used the rowing machines for their IMYC Entry Point. The theme was "Challenge" and in small groups they tried to cover as much distance as possible in 30 min. The best team rowed a distance of more than 6,800m!

Grade 9 students were faced with a special challenge. They competed against a teacher team over a distance of 500m. With exceptional effort from all participants, the eight fastest students beat the teachers by 19 seconds.
